



## Large Pew Bow

Your walk down the aisle will be even more special with these pew bows lovely enough to make a florist jealous!

### Materials

- 2 Floral stems with large flowers
- Pearl berry cluster
- Satin ribbon for bow
- Dry foam pew clip
- 3" Wooden wired picks
- [Floral tape](#)
- [Decorative cording](#)
- 22-gauge wire
- [Glue gun](#) and [glue](#)

### Directions

1. Cut the stems on two large dominant flowers to the desired length. Make a 9-loop bow from the ribbon. Insert the bow into the middle of a dry foam pew clip. Place the two large dominant flowers into the top of the dry foam above the bow.
2. Wrap wire around stems of large and small leaves. Place the leaves around the large flowers using the leaves as a "collar." Place the smaller leaves into the center of the arrangement just above the bow.
3. Cut pearl berry clusters into several small pieces. Attach them to 3-inch wooden wired picks and secure with floral tape. Place picks in the pew arrangement. Leave a few berries to attach to the ends of the decorative cording.
4. Make a simple bow with decorative cording. Secure with 22-gauge wire and insert it into the dry foam through the center of the satin bow. Hot glue the individual berries into a cluster at the bottom of the decorative cording. Make additional single loops from the decorative cording as desired and secure with 22-gauge wire and floral tape. Pick into the loops of the satin bow.

Approximate Crafting Time: 25-30 minutes
