



Simple Cell Phone Pouches

These stylish bags are great for lots more than just toting your cell phone! Keep keys handy, stash cash and credit cards, or keep tabs on specs and other small accessories. Great alternative to a bulky purse or bag!

Materials

- ¼ yd. wool felt, any color
- scraps of wool felt, assorted colors
- assorted embellishments: beads, beaded fringe, ribbons, trims, embroidery floss

Tools

- basic sewing supplies
- glue

Directions

1. Cut two 4"x8" rectangles and one 2½" square for belt loop.
2. Stitch 2½" square to one rectangle, placing edge of square ½" from short side of rectangle. Stitch top and bottom of square leaving side edges open to form belt loop.
3. Add trims and embellish front of bag as desired.
4. With wrong sides together, stitch front to back at sides and bottom of bag.
5. Fold down top ½" of bag if desired and stitch or add trims.

Hint 1: To add hanging cord, measure length around neck as desired. Stitch edges of cording to inside of back at top edge.

Hint 2: To adjust size of bag for smaller cell phone, cut the 2 rectangles 4"x6".

Approximate Crafting Time: 1 hr.
